Ted and Fran

Ted is green with black spots.

Jess has a pet hen, Fran.
Fran is red with black flecks.
Jess lets Fran run in the grass.
Fran likes to peck in the mud.

Cass spots a red pup in the grass.
The pup sniffs and sniffs.
“Jess, look at the red pup!”
Jess spots the pup.
“The pup is not a pup, Cass. It is a fox!”

Cass grabs Ted.
Jess grabs Fran.
The fox will not get Ted and Fran.

Russ and His Dog

Russ and his dog run up the hill.
Russ has a black hat. It fell.
His dog grabs the black hat and runs.
His dog drops the hat in the grass.

Russ looks for his black hat.
Russ spots a green frog in the grass.
Russ spots fox tracks in the mud.
Russ sees a bug spin a web.
But Russ can not spot his black hat.

Russ has a plan.
Russ looks for his dog.
He spots his dog and his hat.
Russ grins. "You had it. Bad dog!"

black, grabs, drops, grass, spot(s), green, frog, tracks, spin, plan, grins

Consonants *ss /s/*

Russ, grass

High-Frequency Words

and, the, a, looks, for, green, sees, he, you

At the Pond

The sun is up.
Frog sits on a stump.
Frog looks at the sun.
The sun is hot.
Frog is hot.

Frog can bend his legs.
Frog can jump in the pond.
Frog can get wet.

Frog can see a bug.
Frog can stop that bug.
Flick! Flick!
Frog will stop the bug.

Frog can see a nest of ducks.
The nest has small ducks in it.
A big duck swims at him.
Frog must jump up.
Frog gets back on his stump.

Frog is on his stump.
At last, Frog can rest!

Flip left the bin.
Flip went to the step. Fuzz fell.
Flip ran past the desk. Fuzz fell.

Flip did a big jump to a sill.
Flip felt the hot sun on his back.
Flip had a nap.

Fran got up.
Fran did not spot Flip.
But Fran did spot fuzz.
It was on the quilt.
It was on that step.
It was on the desk.

That fuzz led Fran to Flip.
The fuzz mess just slept.
Fran had to grin.
